Lutcher High School Bomb Threat

On the morning of April 9, 2025 at approximately 10:15 a.m. Lutcher High School received a phone call alleging a bomb on campus.

At that time, LHS administration enacted the St. James Parish Schools emergency procedures and protocols. The St. James Parish Sheriff's Office was notified of the threat and deputies were dispatched to campus.

LHS administration began a full evacuation of the building. Shortly after the building was evacuated it was determined that students would be dismissed for the day. The dismissal plan was communicated to parents, and campus was cleared of all students.

At this time, we are working in coordination with the St. James Parish Sheriff's Office on the origin of the threat.

Superintendent Kimball says of the situation, "It is an unfortunate event. When things like this happen, it is another day of teaching and learning missed. We are very glad that all students and staff are safe and that our procedures that we have set forth were followed swiftly. Thank you to the Lutcher High School students, staff and administration along with the St. James Parish Sheriff's Office and other law enforcement agencies who assisted in the incident today."
