All students should have a supply of loose-leaf paper, pens, pencils, erasers, spiral notebooks, and pocket folders. Additional items may be requested throughout the school year.

Physical Education

All Classes: Change of clothes suitable for safe participation in physical activity: t-shirt or sweatshirt, shorts or sweatpants (no cut-offs; no buckles, snaps, zippers that could pose a safety concern) shoes appropriate for safe participation in physical activity (rubber non-marking sole; no open back or open toe shoes)

Biology/Anatomy and Physiology/AP Bio: Pencils/erasers, composition notebook, folder, calculator, dry-erase marker & highlighter

Physics, AP Physics 1 & Forensic Science: Dry erase markers calculator (scientific or graphing)

Special Education
