2026-2027

- 2 plastic school pencils boxes (**no metal**, approx. 8.5"x5.5"x2")
- 4-5 cans of playdoh (regular size)
- 6-8 Elmer's jumbo disappearing purple glue sticks
- 4 Expo chisel tip dry erase markers (multicolor)
- 1 box Crayola classic broad line markers
- Wired Headphones (**over the head**) in a labeled clear Ziploc bag (not rechargeable!)
- A small family photo (to hang in cubby)
