Headphone Information

For the health and safety of our students, we ask that every student brings his/her own set of headphones. These headphones will remain at school and should not be kept in backpacks, where they are easily broken and often left at home.

Requirements:

- Standard 3.5 mm jack
- NO Bluetooth (Doesn't work well in the tech lab or when devices are near other devices)
- Sized to fit your child
- No microphone needed
- Foldable is acceptable but not required (Note: they tend to break more easily) •

4th-6th only: Earbuds are okay to use IF students can put them in without help

Labeling Instructions:

- Completely unpack the headphones and remove any twist ties and plastic pieces that may be used in packaging.
- Using a permanent marker, please write the first and last name ON the headphones.
- Using a permanent marker, label the outside of the bag with first and last name, grade, and teacher's name.
- Place headphones in a Ziploc type bag. Please make sure your child can easily put in and take out the headphones independently. Gallon size bags work best for headphones, while quart size bags are fine for earbuds.
