Dress Code

Things to remember when purchasing clothes for the upcoming school year:

- **NO** spaghetti straps/tube tops
 - ALL tank tops must fit closely under the arms.
 - Clothing should have adequate coverage to allow a full range of movement without skin or undergarments showing.

 - Clothing must cover the entire buttocks and extend a reasonable length to ensure modesty.

Student Activity Pass

Student Device Distribution

Casteel is a 1:1 technology school. Parents and student will need to complete the 1:1 Device Agreement on the Parent Portal in Infinite Campus by Friday, July 10th.

Students that are new to CCHS may receive their device during Colt Day in the Tech Hub (across from the Cafeteria). Devices will be distributed from 8-11:00 and 12-2:00.

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Testing

These tests are very popular, and spots fill up quickly. Each test is non-refundable.

PSAT NMSQT

The PSAT/NMSQT will be held Saturday, October 17th. Priority registration for juniors will open in late July with registration for sophomores and freshmen beginning in mid-August. The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test is a great tool for students considering college. The PSAT/NMSQT measures the key reading, writing, and mathematic skills you are learning in high school that are essential for college and career readiness. We recommend that students take the PSAT/NMSQT in order to receive feedback about strengths and weaknesses, enter the competition for the National Merit Scholarship Program (11th graders only) and to help prepare for the SAT. Please keep an eye out for communication through Parent Square.

AP Testing

Students enrolled in an AP course for the 2026–2027 school year will need to register for their respective exam(s) in their College Board MyAP account once they enter the Join Code they receive from their teacher. The cost for each test is \$110 (\$150 for AP Seminar & Research). These fees will be assigned to individual student accounts in October through Infinite Campus once students have verified that they will be taking the exam.
