Academically, our students demonstrated growth across all major state-tested subjects, including mathematics, science, and English language arts. Beyond the classroom, our Lions continued to excel in athletics, advancing to playoff competition in multiple sports and representing our school community with pride, perseverance, and determination.

One of our primary goals will be strengthening literacy and critical thinking skills across all content areas.
