1. What was the total amount of the district's Section 31a allocation for the 2025-26 school year?

\$546,392.08

2. Describe the district's methodology and decision-making for distributing Section 31a At-risk grant funds to target the buildings with the highest needs.

We identify the at-risk identified students throughout the district based on the 31a eligible criteria. Once all at-risk students have been identified, we review the eligibility criteria to determine the scope of services that are needed in order to address the intervention needs. We also gather feedback from staff and parents on intervention supports needed.

3. What evidence-based interventions and services were implemented with the Section 31a At-risk grant funds during the 2025-26 grant cycle?

Due to the high number of at-risk students at the elementary school and intensive supports needed, the district allocated resources for reading intervention, social work, and class size reduction. We also provide academic intervention and social work supports at the high school. The district also incorporated evidence based tutoring practices for all students in the district.

4. In what ways has the district collected feedback from parents or legal guardians on these interventions and services provided this year?

Feedback has been collected from parents through survey data and informal conversations about academic supports needed for students.

5. Describe the method parents or legal guardians may use to provide feedback on the use of these funds.

Parents provide informal feedback and survey responses regarding use of the funds.
