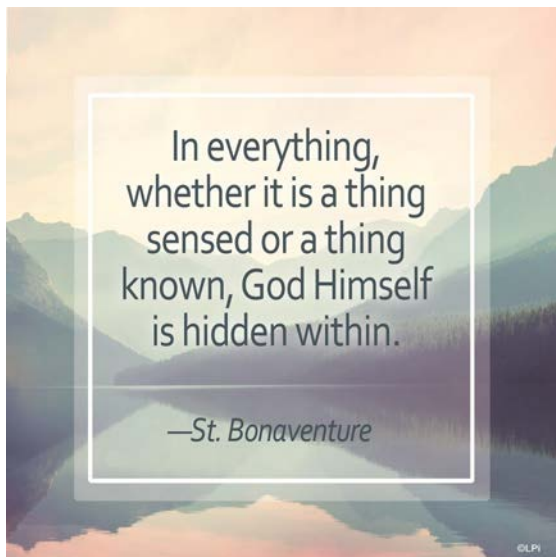

Hello Everyone,

I am Fr. Dan Whalen. Thank you for all your prayers and warm welcomes. I am very excited to be here at Divine Child as one of your priests. I am looking forward to meeting you all this summer and this coming school year. Please pray for me as I pray for you.

A little about me. I grew up in a family of six with two brothers and one sister in West Bloomfield, MI. My family would attend Our Lady of Refuge in Orchard Lake for Sunday Mass, and I went to Our Lady of Refuge for grade school from K-8. For high school, I went to Orchard Lake St. Mary's Preparatory and graduated in 2018. There I was on the crew team winning States, Midwest, and going to Nationals.

During my Senior year in high school amid rowing and studying, I began discerning the call to the priesthood. Shortly after a discernment weekend at Sacred Heart Major Seminary, I applied and entered the Seminary in the Fall of 2018. SAFE ENVIRONMENTS: Volunteer Requirements



UNITED STATES CONFERENCE OF

The Archdiocese of Detroit, in compliance with the USCCB Charter for Protection of Youth and Young People, **requires any and all parish and school volunteers to complete Protecting God's Children training and maintain a current background check, regardless of whether they are interfacing with children or vulnerable adults.** Please review the steps below to ensure you are in full compliance.

Create and/or login to VIRTUS Account

VIRTUS is the Church's online system for Protecting God's Children training and volunteer safety compliance. All information shared within VIRTUS is secure and encrypted for online security. Please visit **VIRTUS.org** to get started.

New users: Create an account.

Returning users: Log in with your current credentials to access courses, authorize background checks, recertify or update your information.

Quick tip: Keep your login handy for future training updates or renewals.

Authorize Background Check

Upon registering with VIRTUS, **new users** will provide their date of birth, gender, race, and confirm Michigan residency for the past 7 years, followed by signing and authorizing the background check.

Your VIRTUS account will show the check as cleared once it has been completed by our on-staff VIRTUS coordinator in strict confidentiality.

Review & Sign Volunteer Code of Conduct

All volunteers are required to read and sign the Volunteer Code of Conduct. This can be completed by logging into your VIRTUS account.

If needed, a paper copy may also be reviewed and signed; completion will be recorded in your VIRTUS account under the "Required Documents" tab.

All Divine Child parish and school volunteers - new and currently serving - are expected to complete all four steps prior to volunteering.

Sign up & Attend Protecting God's Children Training

Protecting God's Children (PGC) is a 3-hour awareness session that educates adults on how to recognize inappropriate or predatory behavior, take steps to prevent abuse, and report concerns responsibly.

First-time participants must attend an in-person *Protecting God's Children 4.0* session, while **anyone who completed PGC in 2022 or earlier** may complete a recertification online through the VIRTUS web training module (*Protecting God's Children 4.0* and *Vulnerable Adults 2.0*).

How to Register

All registration is completed online through your VIRTUS account. VIRTUS offers sessions across metro Detroit (see database in your account).

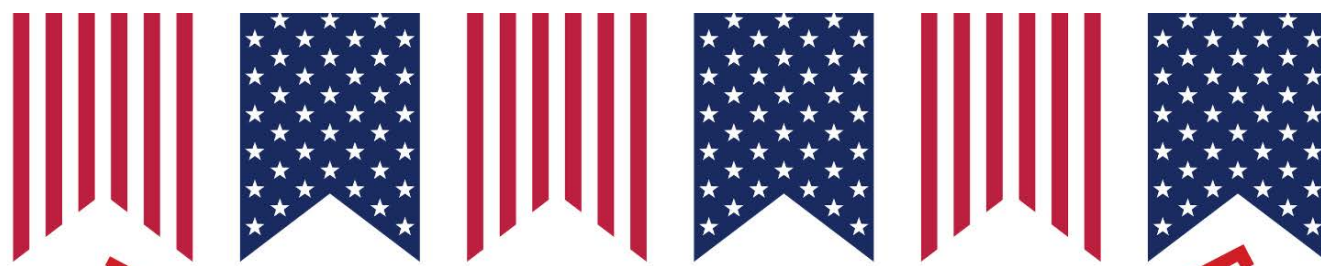

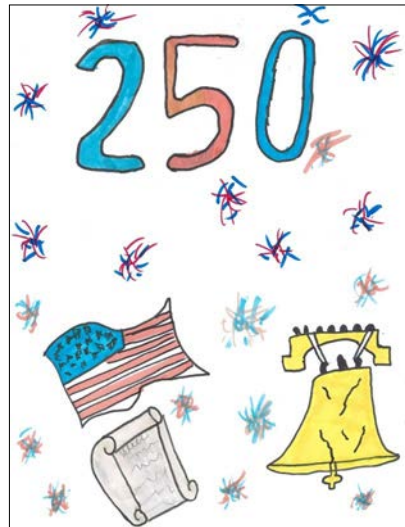

Invite the Holy Spirit to work through you as you answer the questions, remove any barrier or bias, and help you share what works or doesn't work in the proposed models. 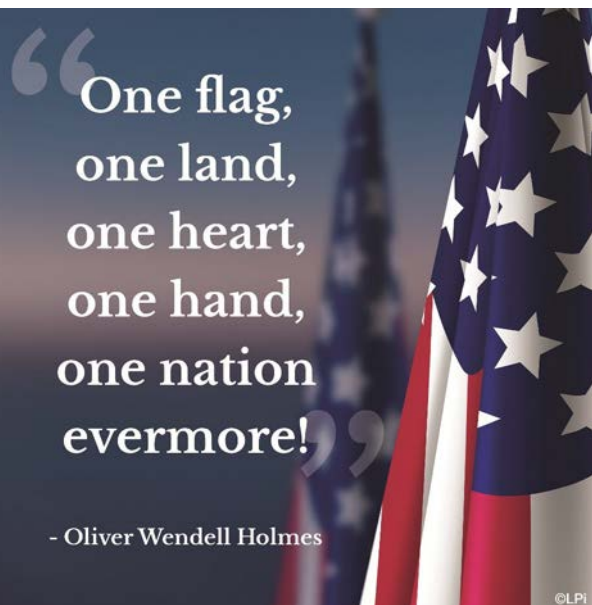

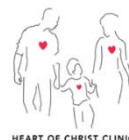

**Right to Life - LIFESPAN****Assisted Suicide & the 2026 Primary Election**

The Michigan State House of Representatives introduced House Bills 5825, 5826, 5827, and 5828 to legalize Assisted Suicide on April 21, 2026. There are both Republicans and Democrats who support and oppose assisted suicide. Legislative analysts report that H.B. 5825-5828 are assigned to the House Committee on Government Operations which will not report them to the full House for consideration in 2026. Most candidates would prefer not to share a public stance on assisted suicide, yet it is clear that if a majority of those elected to the State House and Senate in 2026 favor legalizing assisted suicide, then expect assisted suicide to become legal in Michigan in 2027-28.

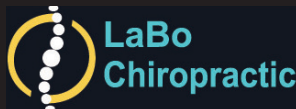

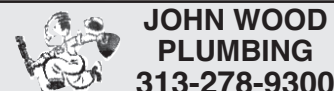
