Our Current Challenges

- ✓ **Surface Limits:** Wood chips are hard to maintain and hinder mobility.
- ✓ **Safety Concerns:** Aging equipment requires repairs - and we can no longer weld the equipment.
- ✓ **Heat Exposure:** Lack of shade makes the space unsafe; we spend at least 30 minutes outside every day.
- ✓ **Exclusion:** The current site does not support students with sensory or physical needs.



Why the Wood Chips Must Go



Accessibility

Modern poured-in-place rubber allows wheelchairs, students on crutches, families with strollers, and walkers to move freely across the entire site.



Cleanliness

No more wood chips in shoes, pockets, or stuck in clothing. Minimal upkeep. Woodchips need replacing each year and continuous upkeep.



Safety

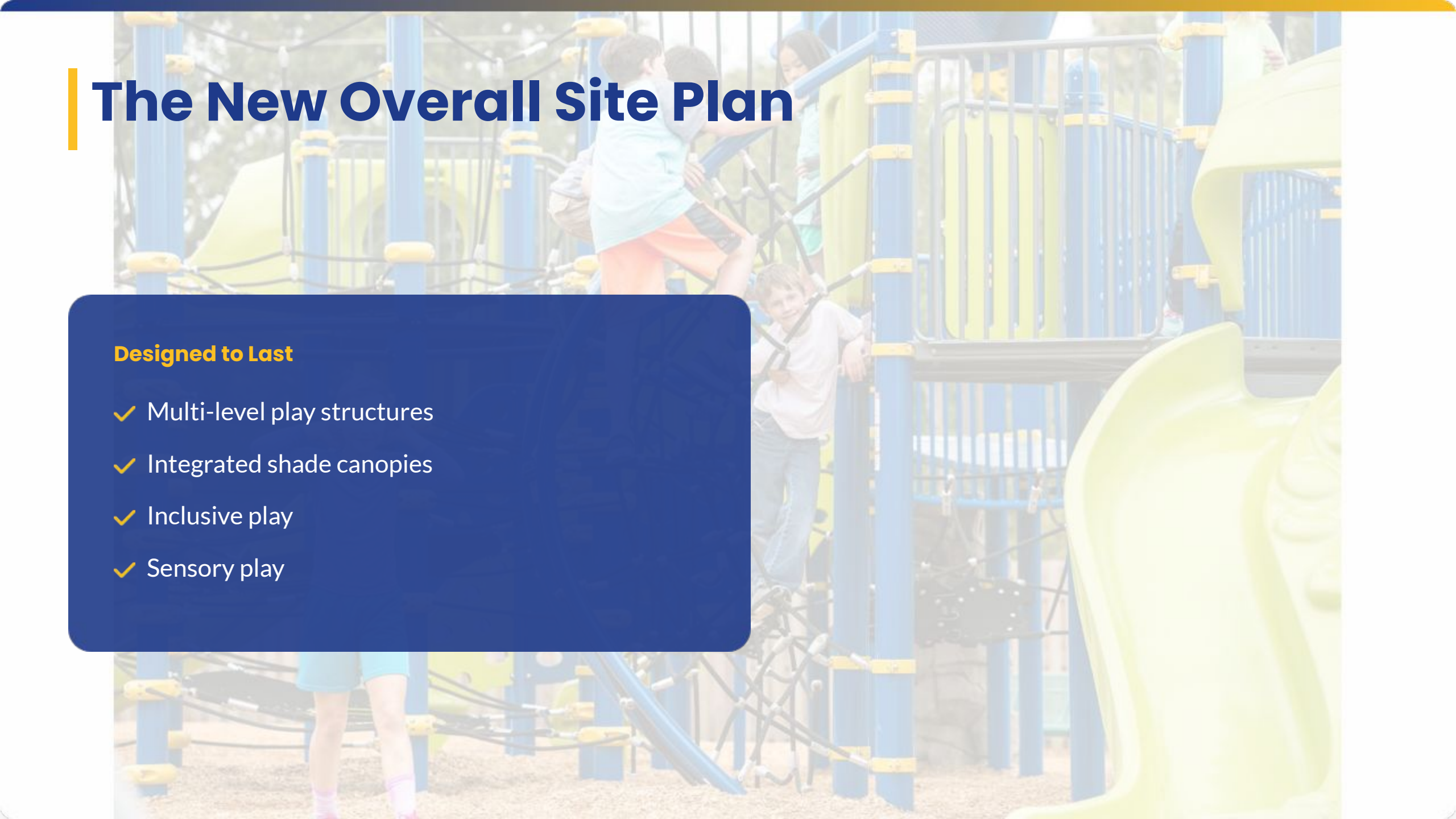
Superior fall protection that doesn't "thin out" in high-traffic areas like swings and slide exits. Reduces trips and falls. No splinters and no mud when wet. Does not attract critters.

- ✓ **Ground-Level Play:** Engaging activities accessible to everyone.
- ✓ **Adaptive Structures:** Safe, supportive seating for all sizes.



Built for Safety and Comfort



Integrated Shade

Our students spend 30+ minutes outdoors daily. The new design incorporates shade structures built directly into the equipment towers.

This lowers surface temperatures and protects skin and keeps equipment cooler.
