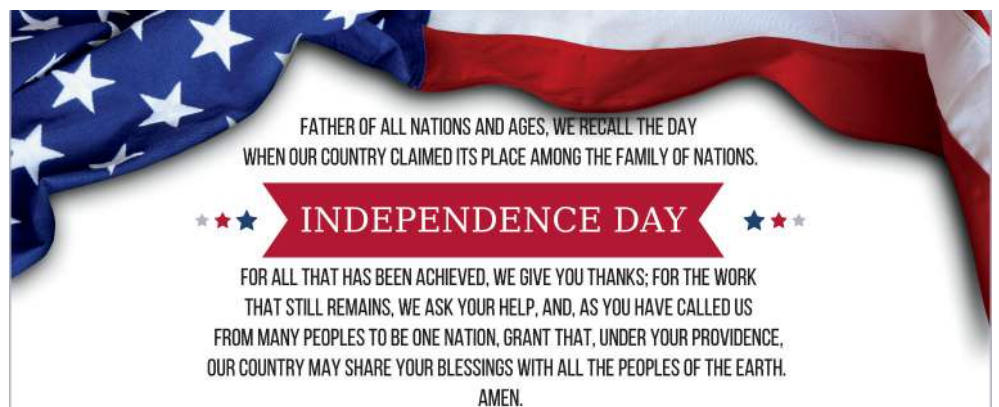
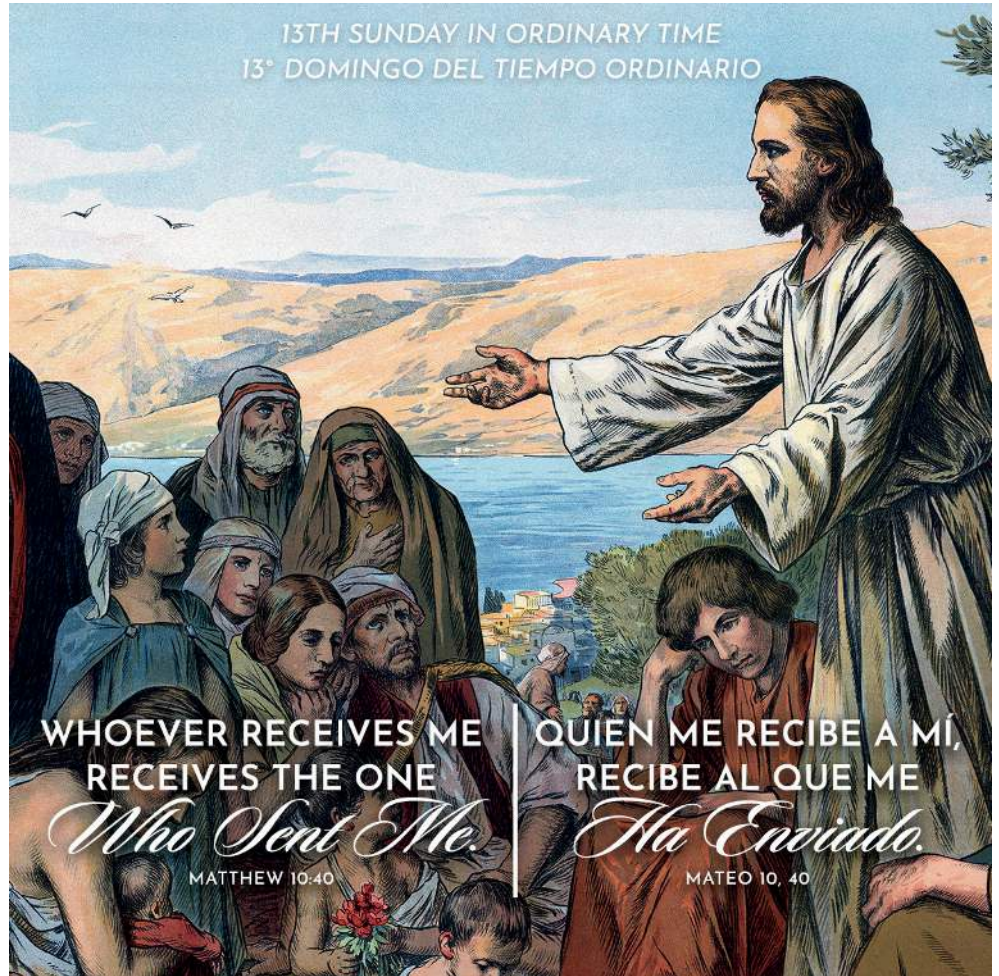

DECIMOTERCER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO (28 DE JUNIO DE 2026)

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús nos dice cómo debemos amarlo si vamos a ser Sus discípulos. San Francisco de Sales observa lo siguiente:

La voluntad de Dios era que Adán amara a Eva con ternura, pero no a tal grado que el complacerla transgrediera la orden que Dios le dio. El amor de nuestra familia, amigos y benefactores es lo que desea Dios. Aun así, podemos llegar a amarlos en exceso. Este también puede ser el caso con nuestra vocación, no importa cuán espiritual, e incluso con nuestras devociones cuando las amamos como si fueran nuestra finalidad. Debemos recordar que estos solo son medios para alcanzar nuestro propósito definitivo: el amor de Dios.

¿Por qué surge nuestro amor excesivo por las personas y las cosas? Porque esas cosas que debiéramos amar conforme a la voluntad de Dios, las amamos por otras causas y motivos. Puede que esos motivos no sean contrarios a Dios, pero están al margen de Él. Es decir, se centran más en nuestros deseos que en aquello que Dios desea para nosotros.

Aun así, hay almas que aman solo aquello que Dios desea y de la manera en que Dios lo desea para ellos. Bienaventuradas son realmente dichas almas porque aman verdaderamente a Dios, a sus amigos en Dios, e incluso aman a sus enemigos por Dios. Es a Dios a quien ellos aman por sobre todas las cosas, e incluso en todas las cosas. Estas almas son excepcionales y singulares. Son como pescadores de perlas que no dicen que están pescando ostras sino perlas. Estas grandes almas encuentran la perla que es la amorosa presencia de Dios en todas las personas y todas las cosas, y esa es la razón de su dicha.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús nos urge a amar del modo en que Dios quiere que amemos. Para desear lo que Dios desea para nosotros, debemos despojarnos de todo aquello en nuestros deseos y afectos que no procede de Dios. Entonces seremos libres de amar a todas las personas y cosas en Cristo y para Cristo. Es la presencia del amor divino de Cristo en nosotros lo que nos permite convertirnos en sus discípulos.

SENIOR MOMENTS

GIVING UP THE KEYS

For most older people, deciding to stop driving is a tough choice. It can feel even worse when our children take away our car keys after noticing we're not driving as safely as before. Feeling angry or upset is normal, since losing the ability to drive feels like losing our independence, something we all value. Still, if we live long enough, we all reach this point eventually.

A few months ago, I chose to give up my car. I had thought about it for a long time, hoping that eye surgery would help my vision enough to make me feel safe driving again. For a while, it did. But over time, I started to notice small changes that made me less comfortable behind the wheel. After a trip to Costco one day, I decided it was time to hand over my keys. To my surprise, it wasn't hard, and I actually felt free. I remembered a question people often ask when making decisions: "Is the benefit worth the risk?" For me, the answer was clearly no. As we get older, some things become more important, and our priorities shift. A year ago, I couldn't imagine life without my car, but now I'm happy not to have to worry about inspections, repairs, fuel, maintenance, insurance, taxes, and licensing.

I'm fortunate to live in an active retirement community that offers so many amenities. Twice a month, Library Resources visits with books, and a medical clinic, a pharmacy, a bank, hair salons, and fitness centers are on campus. Additionally, the community offers a free shopping shuttle service that runs to different areas four mornings a week. I must admit that taking the shuttle takes more time than driving myself, but by planning and allowing enough time, I'm able to purchase the things I need outside the big grocery runs with my daughter. I'm also fortunate to have so many caring friends here, younger than I, who generously offer rides to medical appointments and Mass regularly. These acts of kindness have allowed deeper friendships to grow, enriching my life. I'm so very blessed!

Over the past few months, my life has felt calmer. I've learned to plan my time better to make sure I get what I need, but in many ways, my quality of life has actually improved. The saying "less is more" really fits for me now. It feels like I'm decluttering my life in a new way.

This process can be vastly different for someone who doesn't live in the supportive environment I do. If you've decided to age in place, know that many services are available through the Fairfax Area Agency on Aging, and the Shepherd's Center of Northern Virginia provides free rides to medical appointments, grocery shopping, and other offerings to area seniors. For those of you who are thinking it might be time to stop driving, don't hesitate...it's not the end of the world! Life goes on, and by thinking it through, there's always a "Plan B." Most importantly, if you make the decision yourself, you're able to maintain your autonomy and, for most of us, that's critical and even empowering. It's much better than having the car keys taken away, which leaves us feeling indignant, angry, perhaps disrespected, and somehow diminished by the experience. Living with the choices we make for ourselves is easier than with those imposed on us by others.

For me, the happiest part of this story is that I gave the car to my grandson. That vehicle was the first one I ever purchased on my own and was the best one I ever had...I loved it! Now it's his turn to do the same. He told me that every time he turns the key in the ignition, he thinks about how grateful he is to have me in his life still. It can't get any better than that!
