 - New Craig Road Elementary School
 - Permit has been issued on Craig Road and construction is underway!
 - Masonry is set to start following the completion of the water line tie-in the week of June 8th. Fire hydrants have been installed on site. Underground site utility installation is ongoing.
 - The County Commissioner has the Craig Road speed limit change Public Hearing is scheduled for July 7th.
