2026–2027 Draft Plan

Purpose of the Safety Plan

- Reviewed annually by the District-Wide Safety Team
- Provides the districtwide framework for preparedness, response, recovery, and communication
- Coordinates planning with law enforcement, fire departments, emergency responders, and other agencies
- Public plan provides an overview; confidential building-level response details remain protected

Legal Basis and Annual Review

- Developed pursuant to Commissioner's Regulation 155.17 and Education Law 2801-a
- Public hearing is part of the review process prior to Board adoption
- The draft is made available for public review and comment for the required 30-day period
- Final plan is scheduled for Board consideration after the review period

- Team rosters and emergency communication procedures
- SAVE Hotline, visitor management, and after-school security
- Trauma-informed drills and access/functional-needs planning
- Blue strobe alerts, Secure Lockout, student elopement, CAERP, and transportation planning
