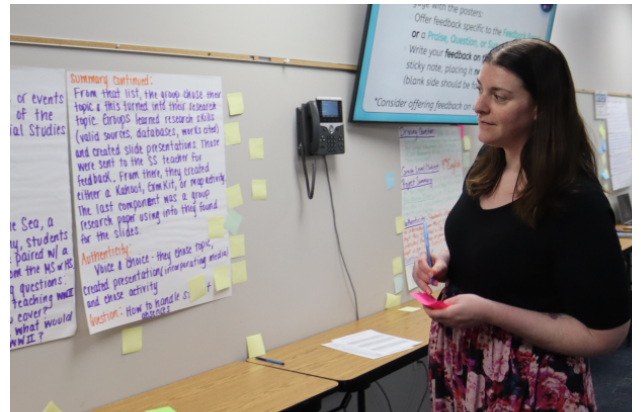
TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE & WORKSHOPS
