

Kindergarten through 8th Grade Transportation Applications

Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Liberty Union High School District is pleased to inform you that we are now accepting school bus applications and bus pass payments electronically for the 2026-2027 school year.

To apply for a bus pass for your student, simply click the link below and enter your student ID number. ***If you don't know it, contact your student's school.***



If your student qualifies for **Special Education** transportation please do not submit an application online. Please contact your school district to apply.

- **PASSES ARE AVAILABLE ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS**
- **AN APPLICATION MUST BE INPUT FOR EACH STUDENT**
- **Students must have a bus pass with them to ride the school bus** (*see rule 15*).
- General education kindergarten through 8th grade students are NOT eligible for transportation if they are attending a school other than their home school or live within a one (1) air mile radius of the school.
- **All Applications must be done online using the link below**

Once your application is approved you will receive an email with the word "transportation" in the subject line. Follow the instructions on how to submit payment (if applicable) electronically, and how to print a receipt and the bus route information from the comfort of your own home. **BUS PASSES MUST BE SIGNED FOR AND PICKED UP AT 19 OAK STREET, BRENTWOOD, CA, AFTER** you receive the Bus Pass Pick Up email from libertybus@luhsd.net

You may qualify for free transportation. The Free Transportation Qualification Schedule is on page 2.

BUS RULES AND REGULATIONS

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| 1. Obey the authority of the bus driver. | 9. No animals, reptiles or insects allowed on the bus. |
| 2. Be at the bus stop 10 minutes before pick-up time. | 10. Do not destroy or deface property, or litter on the bus; Parent/Guardian will be held financially responsible. |
| 3. Remain seated. | 11. Students will be escorted by driver only . |
| 4. If bus is equipped with seat belts, seat belt must be worn at all times. | 12. Student's behavior is to be orderly before, during and after bus arrival. |
| 5. Keep hands and head inside the bus at all times. | 13. No eating, drinking, gum chewing, vaping or smoking on the bus. |
| 6. Be courteous to others. No inappropriate language or racial slurs. Bullying is grounds for expulsion from riding. | 14. No loud distracting noises. This includes but is not limited to music, phones, talking, yelling and screaming. |
| 7. Students are to remain quiet at railroad crossings. | 15. Bus pass must be scanned when boarding and exiting the bus and shown upon request. It may not be used by any other student. |
| 8. No glass, hazardous material, skateboards, roller blades weapons, radios, laser pointers or balls allowed on the bus. Any large instruments or athletic items must be stowed in the storage compartment under the bus where equipped. | 16. Students must use assigned bus stop. |
| | 17. Students must NOT approach bus after it leaves stop. |

You will need to enter your district's 4-letter code before the student's ID number,

for example: **Brentwood = BUSD** BUSD1234567 **Oakley = OUSD** OUSD1234567

PLEASE READ PAGE 2 FOR FREE BUSSING ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION.

FREE TRANSPORTATION QUALIFICATION

When applying for free transportation, income verification MUST be attached.

If you do not attach your proof of income the application will be disqualified.

BELOW ARE THE ELIGIBLE FORMS OF VERIFICATION OF INCOME.

- Free or reduced lunch approval letter –

This is the only item that is accepted for transportation July 27, 2026 through June 4, 2027.

(Submit an application to the district the student attends school in and attach the letter of approval).

PROOF OF INCOME SHOWN BELOW IS VALID FOR ONE QUARTER ONLY: You will need to reapply for bus transportation each quarter if you submit any of the items below.

- 3 most recent pay stubs – valid for ONE quarter
- 3 most recent Social Security payments – valid for ONE quarter
- Recent* proof of Welfare/AFDC/Unemployment – valid for ONE quarter
- Recent* proof of child support – valid for ONE quarter
- Recent* proof of spousal support – valid for ONE quarter
- Recent* proof of pension or retirement – valid for ONE quarter
- Recent* proof of disability benefits – valid for ONE quarter

*Recent means within the last 30 days.
