Grades 10-12, Online Day via Canvas - Tuesday, September 1

- All students in Grades 10-12 will engage in a robust, structured asynchronous day online on Tuesday, September 1.
- Students will NOT report to Shakopee High School, in-person, until Wednesday, September 2.
- Though students will not be receiving live direct instruction for each course, students must log in to each class on Canvas throughout the duration of the school day on September 1.
