#### For the 2026-2027 school year:

**Hospital Homebound** will increase academic support to all HHB K-12 students by integrating more technology into their meetings with students.

**Paulding College and Career Academy** will increase student workforce readiness by ensuring that at least 50% of 3rd level students demonstrate competency in key employability skills as evidenced by participation in mock interviews, resume development, and participation in local industry supported career exploration.

**Paulding Virtual Academy** will strengthen the consistency and depth of progress monitoring across all EOC content areas by refining benchmark assessment practices, increasing teacher accountability for intervention documentation, and expanding data-driven instructional planning during PLCs.

**Phoenix** program will improve student engagement among virtual learners and attendance in the live sessions.
