At the start of the 2025–26 school year, twenty-five schools across the district utilized Prop 28 funding to support dedicated visual and performing arts programs. These schools employed a combined total of 23.75 certificated educators specializing in visual arts, media arts, theater, dance, and music. Through these programs, students engaged in rich artistic experiences that fostered creativity, collaboration, and self-confidence.

Over the course of the year, 13,085 students, ranging from preschool through eighth grade, actively participated in Prop 28-funded arts instruction. These opportunities not only enhanced students' ability to express themselves but also developed critical thinking and problem-solving skills essential for future success. While three schools were unable to fill their posted arts positions during the 2025–26 school year, those positions remain open and are expected to be filled for the 2026–27 school year, expanding access to high-quality arts education even further.
