

John Muir Uniform Policy

Uniforms are required on all school days, with the exception of Spirit Days. Students who have earned a free-dress pass may use it on specific days. Students who are not in uniform will be lent clothing items.

John Muir's uniform closet has been established for families that need assistance. John Muir families are encouraged to donate/exchange uniforms that are in good condition to our uniform closet.

S H I R T S		Allowed - Shirts in <u>solid</u> white, gray, black, green, yellow, or purple - John Muir spirit shirts (clubs, activities, etc.) - Shirts that cover the student's torso Not Allowed - Shirts may not be see-through. Undergarments may not be visible. - Shirts may not have logos or images larger than the bottom of a soda can (unless it is a John Muir spirit shirt). No patterns.
B O T T O M S		Allowed - Pants/Jean in <u>solid</u> tan, black or grey - Shorts in <u>solid</u> tan, black or grey - Skirts in <u>solid</u> tan, black or grey - Sweats and Leggings in <u>solid</u> tan, black or grey All bottoms need to be around the waist and cannot be showing undergarments (including shorts worn underneath the bottoms). Not Allowed - No blue jeans - Any see-through pants/bottoms. No bottoms with rips above the knee - No big logos or patterns on pants/bottoms
S H O E S		Not Allowed - Any shoe that is not appropriate for the activity - High heels - Shoes with wheels - Shoes without back support for the heel (Crocs may be worn in "sports mode") - No flip flops/slides/slippers at any time
O T H E R		Allowed - Jackets and sweatshirts that are solid white, gray, black, green, yellow or purple without images or logos that are larger than the bottom of a soda can. - John Muir sweatshirts Not Allowed - No Baseball caps/ Beanies (see footnote). No Bandanas. - No majority red or blue clothing/shoes/socks/backpacks - No professional sport teams logos on clothing/shoes/socks/backpacks - PE uniform clothes may only be worn during PE class. (Per SJUSD, a change of clothing is required for PE class.) Per San Jose Unified School District's Handbook, attire or grooming depicting or advocating violence, criminal activity, gang-related activity (including professional sports wear and/or colors identified by the Santa Clara County Sheriff or San José Police Department as gang-affiliated), use of alcohol or drugs, pornography, or hate speech are prohibited. Specifically, this year we will not be allowing the following items on campus. → Baseball caps/Beanies → Clothing with professional sports logos → Clothing items with the "Cookies" logo and/or other cannabis or alcohol companies
