THE PROCESS:

**Please note that allotted parking spots are given on a first come first served basis*

Complete ALL paperwork including the design and have it approved by Assistant Principal Mr. McClellan in Corral 7, room 210 and choose a space for painting from Mr. McClellan and lastly return to Bookkeeper's office.

- What you need:
 - A signed copy of the Reserved Painted Parking Space Contract (attached)
 - A copy of the design for your parking spot **MUST** be attached or drawn on the contract and must be approved prior to painting; We will keep this, so make a copy for yourself.
 - All designs must be completed on the Senior Parking Design Request form and returned to the front office *after approval by Mr. McClellan*. Your design should be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space.
 - The design may not exceed the parking space outline, and it must be school appropriate and follow the below guidelines.

Mandatory Paint Options:

- You will provide your own paint. (Consider sharing with others.)
- **Paint can only be water based exterior latex; no spray, reflective or fluorescent permitted**

Prohibited:

- **No offensive language, pictures, or symbols.**
- **No negative or rude language (Be nice).**
- **No "gang-style tagging."**
- **No double entendre (Double meanings).**
- **You may use YOUR NAME.** If you want to use a nickname it must be approved. (A boyfriend's or girlfriend's name is **NOT** allowed.)
- **Prohibited items** will be painted over at the discretion of Administration. Disciplinary action may be taken & you may forfeit your right to a parking space and /or to park on campus.
- **No flags or political slogans**

PAINTING DAY: THE LAST DAY TO PAINT YOUR SPOT IS AUGUST 21,2026

- **Step 1:** *IF* you need clarification on paint type, check in with Mr. McClellan
What you need:
 - your paint
 - copy of your approved design – so you will have your approved template to follow. **You must follow this design exactly – no changes allowed.**
- **Step 2:** Begin painting.
What you need:
 - your copy of your approved design
 - a broom to sweep off your spot before painting. (This will save you lots of time.)
 - paintbrushes, paint, or painter's tape and any other supplies you may need
 - **DO NOT FORGET TO PAINT YOUR PARKING PERMIT # ON YOUR SPOT**

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:

- Upon purchasing my parking spot, I will only use water-based exterior latex paint.
- I understand that I must check-in with Mr. McClellan before I begin to paint.
- I know I am not allowed spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- I will only paint within the 3" border I must first label with painters tape.
- I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot.
- I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space.
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my parking space.
- I understand that my painted design must be completed by August 21, 2026
- **If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will be taken away, will be painted over, and I will not receive a refund.**
- **If I paint in someone else's spot, I will be held responsible.**
- **If I do not use my painted parking space, I am still responsible for the space.**
- **Once I've paid for and painted any part of the parking space, there are no refunds, even if OHS should have to go to remote instruction; NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- If I park in someone else's painted parking spot, I will receive disciplinary action.
