

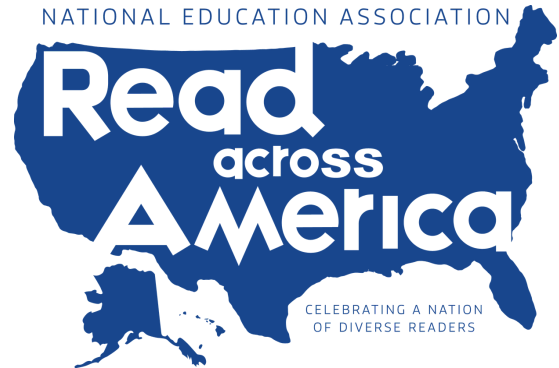

SEELEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT

During Reading Across America, upper grade students took on important leadership roles across the school.
