

STUDENT DRESS GUIDELINES



TOPS



Tops may NOT be worn that:

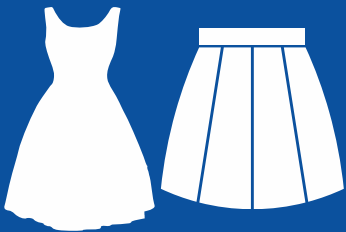
- Are immodestly undersized, including crop tops, tops that are tight, low-cut or show cleavage or stomach when the arms are raised and tops with spaghetti straps.
- Depict or reference alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons, nudity, gang affiliation, death, violence, vulgar/obscene language or images/insults to race, religion, gender or ethnicity, emblems/writing that could be deemed controversial/political and any emblems/writing that may cause a disruption or interference with normal school operations.

PANTS/BOTTOMS



- Torn, cut/slashed material higher than fingertip length that reveals any area of skin or undergarments not allowed unless leggings are worn underneath
- Sheer/see-through leggings/spandex
- Bike shorts/spandex shorts not allowed without an appropriate shirt to cover the bottom
- Sagging or baggy clothing
- All shorts, skirts, jumpers and skorts must be finger-tip length or longer.
- Pants must fit appropriately and at the waist.

DRESSES/SKIRTS



- Slits/kick pleats in skirts or dresses must be at least finger-tip length and modest.
- Dresses with spaghetti straps are not allowed.
- Dresses, skirts, jumpers and rompers must be at least finger-tip length.
- Pre-kindergarten through fifth-grade girls must wear shorts under dresses, skirts and jumpers.

SHOES



- Shoes should be worn that enhance the student's safety.
- Students participating in PE/athletics must wear athletic footwear to participate.
- Maximum shoe height is 2 inches for students in pre-kindergarten through fourth grade.
- Shoes over 2 inches are not recommended for all other grade levels for safety reasons.
- Flip flops, aqua socks and non-athletic toe shoes, slippers, house shoes, skate shoes and Heelies® are not allowed.

JEWELRY & ACCESSORIES



- Jewelry/accessories cannot be a safety hazard.
- Hoods, hats, caps, visors, head coverings, do-rags, bandannas, sweatbands and sunglasses are not allowed in the building.
- Any jewelry, accessories, tattoos that contain vulgar, obscene or offensive images are not allowed (See paragraph in Tops above). *

IDs: Brewer High and Brewer Middle School students must wear school IDs at all times.

Administrative discretion will be given for all dress guideline decisions. Anything deemed to be distracting in the school environment will not be allowed. The principal has the right to appraise any current fashion or fad and determine whether it fits within the dress guidelines. Questions? dcoyle@wsisd.net or 817.367.5389
