Acceptance

Cedarlane Academy is an open-access, neighborhood public school offering the International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years Programme (MYP) for students in grades 6–8. Students residing within the attendance boundaries are enrolled through the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District's online enrollment process. Students from outside the attendance area may request a transfer in accordance with district procedures.

Participation in the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (MYP) is inclusive, all enrolled students are automatically part of the program and are not required to apply, test, or meet specific eligibility criteria. The MYP is designed to support all learners in developing the attributes of the IB Learner Profile and engaging in a globally minded, inquiry-based education. Through the intentional development of Approaches to Learning (ATL) skills, students are empowered to become independent, reflective, and resilient learners.
