

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The City of Cartersville Board of Education has tentatively adopted a 2026 millage rate which will require an increase in property tax by 3.39 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on the tax increase to be held Board Room of the City of Cartersville Board of Education, 15 Nelson Street, on Thursday, August 6, 2026, at 12:00 PM and Thursday, August 6, 2026, at 6:30 PM.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at in the Cartersville High School Auditorium, 320 East Church Street, Cartersville, Georgia 30120, on Monday, August 10, 2026, at 5:30 PM. The Board of Education will consider adoption of the final millage rate at its meeting on Monday, August 10, 2026, at 6:00 PM.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 14.500 mills, an increase of 0.476 mills. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than 14.024 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$400,000 is approximately \$76.16, and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$500,000 is approximately \$95.20.
