

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring and Reporting Requirements not met for Stillwater Twp Elementary School.

Our water system violated drinking water requirements over the past year. Even though it is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation(s).

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether our drinking water meets health standards. During the periods 11/29/25 - 12/12/25 & 12/13/25 - 12/26/25, we did not monitor or test for pH. Therefore, we cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The table below lists the contaminant we did not properly monitor and report during the last year, how often and when we are supposed to sample, how many samples we are required to collect, how many samples we took, and if applicable, the date on which follow-up samples were taken.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do.

However, if you have specific health concerns, a severely compromised immune system, have an infant, are pregnant, or are elderly, you may be at higher risk than other individuals and should seek advice from your health care providers about drinking this water.

What is being done?

pH monitoring resumed on 1/27/26 and has been sampled every two weeks, as required. pH measurements have been in compliance since the lapse of sampling.
