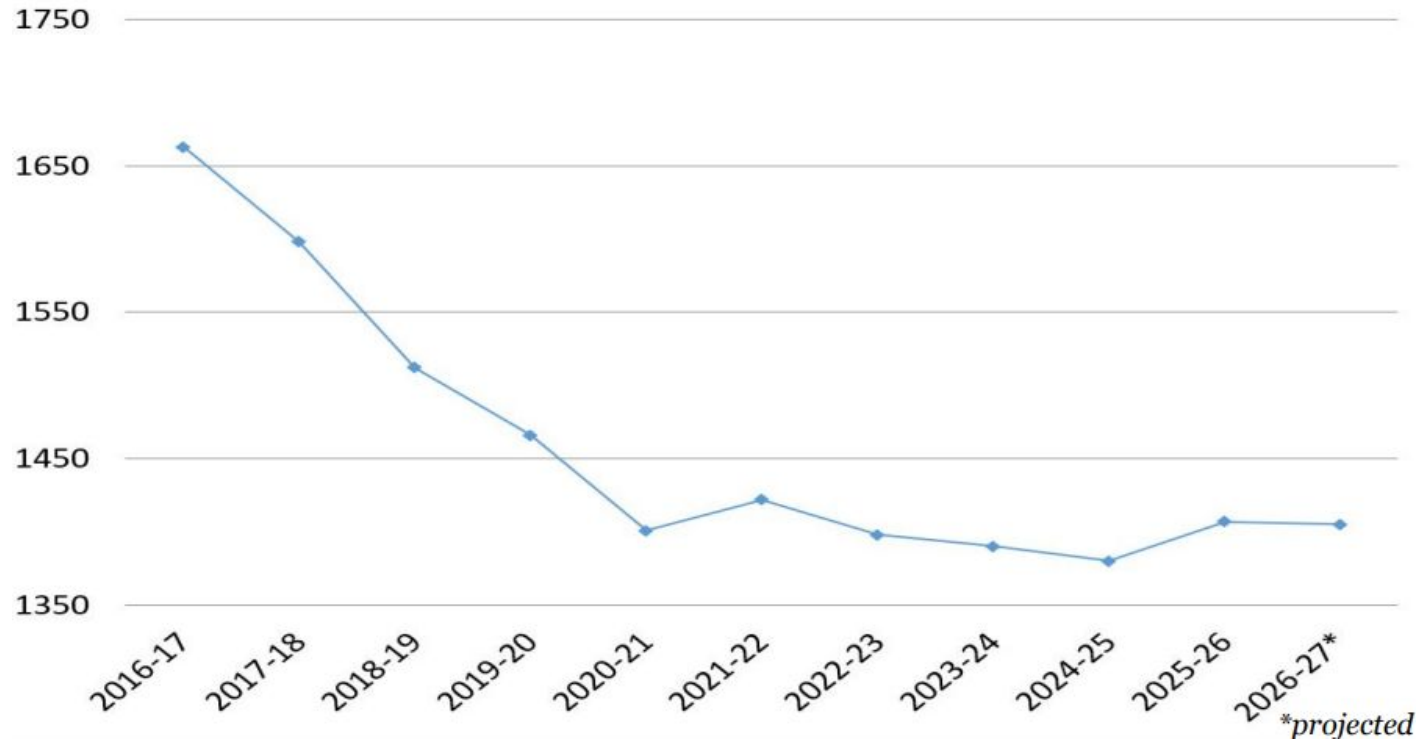

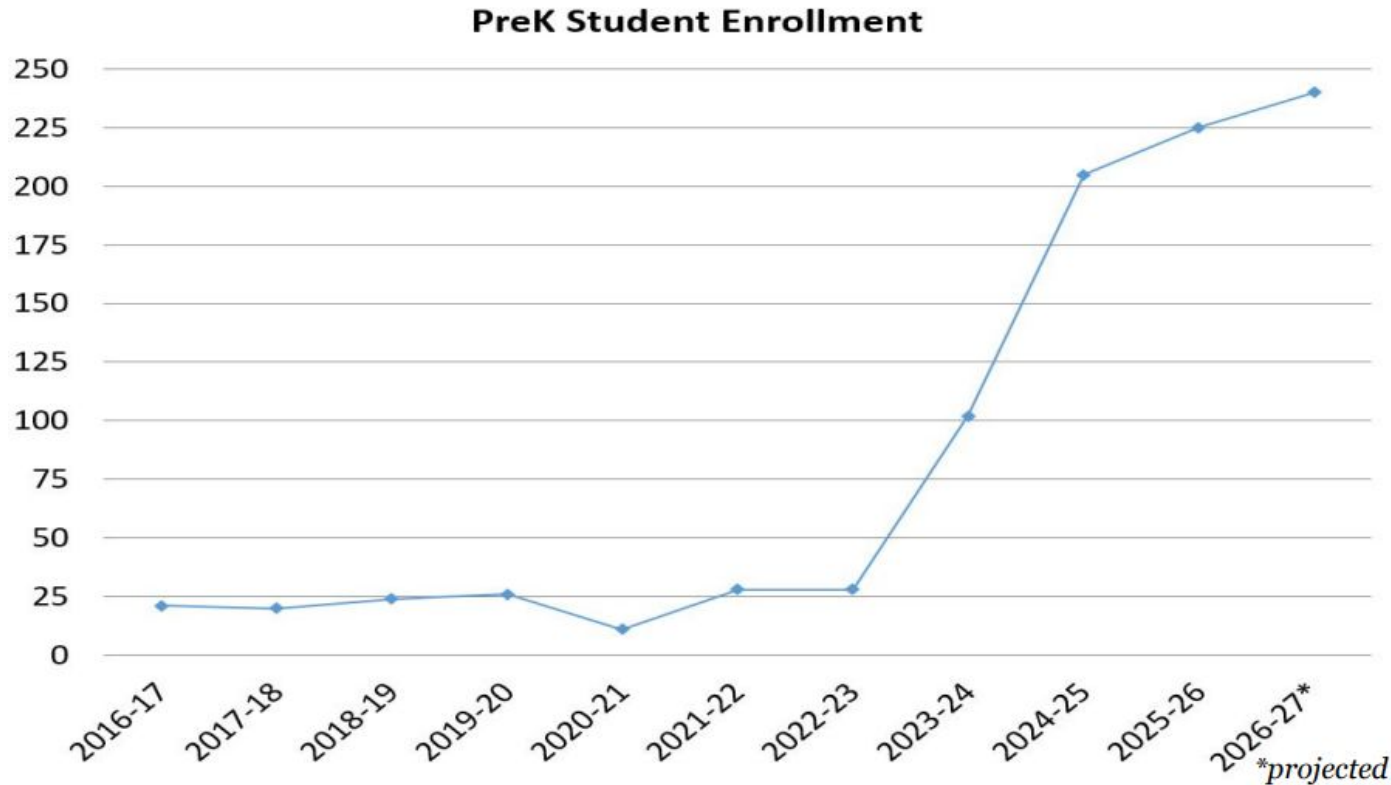
Our Enrollment History K-8

Enrollment Forecast 2026-2027

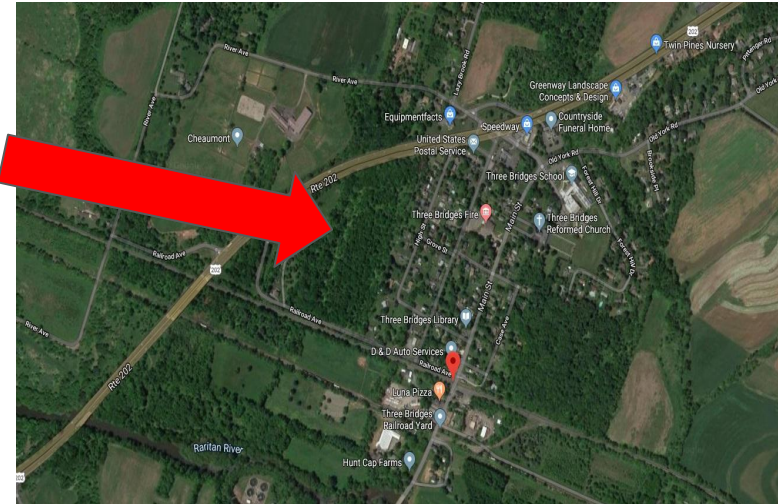

The Redistricting Figures

Phase In Approach: A 5 Year Plan Complete

2021-2022 School Year: Offer families who register for Kindergarten in this redistrict area the option to attend WHS or TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS.

2022-2023 School Year: All entering Kindergarten students in the redistrict area would attend TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS.

2023-2024 School Year: All entering Kindergarten students in the redistrict area would attend TBS. First grade will continue at TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS.

2024-2025 School Year: All entering Kindergarten students in the redistrict area would attend TBS. First and second grade will continue at TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS.

2025-2026 School Year: All entering Kindergarten students in the redistrict area would attend TBS. First, second, third grade will continue at TBS. All new move-ins would be districted to TBS.

2022-2023: 12 Kindergarteners and 10 students in other grades were redistricted to TBS

2023-2024: 11 Kindergarteners and 1 student in other grades were redistricted to TBS

2024-2025: 12 Kindergarteners and 0 students in other grades were redistricted to TBS.

2025-2026: 11 Kindergarteners and 0 students in other grades were redistricted to TBS.

2026-2027: 14 total students (only Kindergarten students)

Total over 5 years: **71** (all current K-3 students)

Staffing Impact 2026-2027

Budget and Staffing Pressures

During the 2026-2027 budget preparation cycle, the district encountered challenges including:

- Higher than typical health benefit premium increases;
- Higher than typical general liability insurance premium increases, and;
- Pension contribution increases (PERS).

In response, we offered employees an early notification of separation agreements to better adjust staffing allocations and plan for any upcoming needs.

Overall savings was approximately **\$1,100,000**

Budget and Staffing Pressures

The following are projected staff reductions by building or department based on the previous year. Total savings of 12 positions.
