

**PINELLAS COUNTY SCHOOLS
CRIMINAL HISTORY SUMMARY
INSTRUCTIONS**

1. This document and your fingerprints will be thoroughly verified by the FBI and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement. If you do not understand the instructions, ask a Human Resources representative for assistance.
2. If any information from your criminal background is left off or you give false or misleading information on this public document, it can and will affect your eligibility for employment. Falsifying this public document is a criminal offense.
3. **On this form you will provide a summary of your criminal history of your entire life.** Pinellas County Schools reserves the right to refuse employment to individuals convicted of crimes pursuant to § 112.01, F.S. and § 435, F.S., as well as those whose arrests and/or convictions do not meet Pinellas County Schools hiring guidelines. An arrest or conviction of a criminal offense does not automatically disqualify you for employment.

PLEASE NOTE: Convicted means a conviction by a jury or by a Court and shall also include the forfeiture of any bail, bond, or other security deposited to secure appearance by a person charged with having committed a felony or misdemeanor, the payment of a fine, a plea of nolo contendere, the imposition of a deferred or suspended sentence by the Court, adjudication withheld, finding or admission of guilt in or out of Court, a plea of no contest, or participation in a pre-trial intervention, pre-trial diversion or similar program.

4. Provide every juvenile charge(s), adult charge(s) and sealed and expunged charge(s) whether they occurred, in this state, another state, a different country or the military.
 - a. List all arrest(s) or criminal charge(s); Whether or not you were prosecuted; Whether or not you were convicted; Whether or not you went to jail; Whether or not the judge or attorney told you the case was dismissed, dropped or no filed
 - b. List all criminal traffic offenses: i.e., DUI, driving while license suspended/revoked, reckless driving, no valid driver license, leaving the scene of an accident, attaching a tag not assigned to vehicle, or violation of driver license restriction(s). (You do not have to list speeding tickets and other minor traffic violations.)
 - c. List all notice(s) to Appear in Court.
 - d. List all summons (Only if you were charged with a crime, not as a witness).
 - e. List all juvenile charges (age 17 and under) on page 4.
 - f. List all sealed or expunged records on page 4
