SUPPLIES NEEDED

- One (1) large backpack (large enough for a large book - no wheels, drawstrings, or extension handles)
- One (1) reusable water bottle
- One (1) toothbrush in travel case
- One (1) tube of toothpaste
- One (1) stick of deodorant
- Two (2) boxes of Crayola crayons
- One (1) box of Crayola colored pencils
- One (1) pair Fiskars brand child-sized scissors
- Twenty (20) Elmers glue sticks
- Two (2) 4 oz. bottles Elmers liquid glue
- Two (2) 1 inch white binder
- Two (2) rolls of Bounty paper towels
- Two (2) boxes of Kleenex
- One (1) box of Ziploc gallon bags
- One (1) package of four containers of Play-Doh
- One (1) old sweatshirt to be left in school in case your child gets cold
- One (1) bath towel/small blanket for resting on or sitting on outdoors
- TWO (2) full changes of clothes to be left in school and labeled with your child's name in them (pants, shirt, socks, and underwear)
- An oversized T-Shirt as an art smock (no fasters or ties please)
