Please Note:

- 1) The substantial equivalent of 180 days of instruction shall be provided each school year. The cumulative hours of instruction for grades 1 through 6 is 900 hours per year or 225 hours per quarter.
- 2) Education Law requires the following subjects to be covered during grades K - 12: Patriotism & Citizenship; Health Education on Alcohol, Drug and Tobacco Misuse; Highway Safety & Traffic Regulations, including Bicycle Safety; and Fire & Arson Prevention and Safety.
- 3) The following courses shall be taught at least once during the first eight grades: US History, NYS History, and the Constitutions of the US and NY State.
- 4) Although some subjects may be taught in integrated fashion (e.g. Health/Science), the IHIP must show content taught for each.
- 5) Bilingual Education or English as a Second Language should be provided where a need is indicated.
