

2026-27 School Supplies: Japanese Track

PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS!

PreK:

- Complete change of labeled clothes (fits in 1-gallon zipbag) *[quantity 2]*
- Small naptime security item; small light blanket (should fit a 1-gallon zipbag)
- Plastic paint shirt with long sleeves
- Rain boots
- Classroom shoes (like Crocs)
- One-piece waterproof trail/rain suit ("Tuffo Unisex Baby Muddy Buddy Coverall" or similar)
- Water bottle (labeled)
- Reusable wet bags *[quantity 2]*
- Reusable shopping bags *[quantity 2]*

LowK:

- Complete change of labeled clothes (fits in 1-gallon zipbag) *[quantity 2]*
- Small naptime security item; small light blanket (should fit a 1-gallon zipbag)
- Plastic paint shirt/apron
- Rain boots
- One-piece waterproof trail/rain suit ("Tuffo Unisex Baby Muddy Buddy Coverall" or similar)

Kinder:

- Complete change of labeled clothes (fits in 1-gallon zipbag)
- Pencil box - about 5" x 8" (simple plastic ones)
- Plastic paint shirt
- Binder: 1" 3-ring, D-ring *[quantity 2]*
- Rain boots/Rain jacket or one-piece waterproof trail/rain suit ("Tuffo Unisex Baby Muddy Buddy Coverall" or similar)
- Classroom shoes (shoes that students can easily take on and off)
- Cloth napkin with lunch daily

1st:

- Complete change of labeled clothes (fits in 1-gallon zipbag or other water-resistant bag)
- Cloth sack or reusable grocery bag for personal belongings (must fit change of clothes)
- Pencil box: about 5" x 8" (simple plastic ones) *[quantity 2]*
- Clipboard: letter size
- Binder: 3-ring 1" wide, D-ring *[quantity 2]*
- Binder: 3-ring ½" wide, D-ring *[quantity 2]*
- Backpack large enough to hold binder folders
- Drawing notebook or wide ruled notebook
- Rain boots and rain jacket
- Handheld pencil sharpener with shavings catcher *[quantity 2]*
- Headphones with a cloth or ziploc bag
- Water bottle (labeled)
- Scissors
- Drawing notebook or wide-ruled notebook



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2nd:

- Backpack large enough to hold a homework folder, lunch bag, water bottle, and a jacket (if a child uses a randoseru, an extra handbag is needed)
- Headphones or earbuds
- A change of clothes (socks, shirt, pants, underwear) in a labeled Ziploc bag
- Hangable tote bag/sack (large enough to put all personal belongings)
- Extra washable spoon/fork
- Extra non-perishable snacks [quantity 3]
- Extra water bottle
- Binder: 3 ring, 1.5" wide (if reusing last year's binders, please bring two 1-inch binders)
- Pencil pouch
- Handheld pencil sharpener (new or high quality)
- Dry-erase whiteboard: 9" x 12"
- Clipboard: 9" x 12 ½"
- 12" ruler with inches and centimeters
- Durable poly expanding file folder, 1 pocket, letter size
- Scissors (new or high quality)

3rd:

- Headphones or earbuds
- Kanji dictionary from second grade
- A change of clothes (socks, shirt, pants, underwear) in a Ziploc bag
- Washable spoon/fork
- Extra non-perishable snacks [quantity 3]
- Extra water bottle
- Hangable cloth sack to put all personal belongings (must fit change of clothes, non-perishable snacks, extra water bottle, and spoon/fork)
- Binder: 3 ring, 1.5" wide
- Expanding poly document wallet (file folder), 1 pocket, letter size ([example](#))
- Simple cloth/poly pencil case or pouch (NOT box type, please)

4th and 5th:

- Headset with noise canceling
- Binders: 3-ring 2" [quantity 2]
- Empty pencil case (small)

Note for fourth and fifth grades: Please no unnecessary items. No extra cloths, food, water bottle, and snacks. Students will learn how to manage those things without backups.
