The Murrieta Valley Unified School District (MVUSD) is proud of the many accomplishments of our students and staff. These accomplishments frequently attract the attention of newspapers, television stations, or other media outlets whose representatives may visit our schools to photograph or film students and staff during school activities.

To protect student privacy, it is MVUSD policy to require parental permission before releasing photos, video, audio recordings, or other multimedia forms that clearly identify a student (unless already covered by the annual Directory Information Notice). MVUSD carefully reviews all requests from outside organizations to ensure our students and their work are highlighted responsibly and appropriately.

Important Note on School Publications: Your consent or denial does not exclude your student from internal student-produced or limited-distribution publications such as the school yearbook, school news broadcast, or school newspaper. If you wish to restrict your student's photo participation or likeness in these specific types of school led-publications, please submit a written request directly to your school principal, in writing via email or the school front office.
