Beginner

Purpose

The purpose of this level is to have fun, enjoy art, and experience different mediums. This is not an in-depth art course where advanced techniques are taught. The Beginner level is designed primarily for enjoyment and exploration, providing a broad overview of different artistic mediums.

If you are looking for more instruction or would like to advance your skills, it is suggested that you enroll in an Intermediate or Advanced level course.

Students seeking advanced, focused instruction in specific artistic mediums.

Within each selected medium, students will complete projects over an extended period of time. These projects may be considered for **IACS State Competition**.
