Important Guidelines

The last day of school is scheduled for June 8. Any snow and/or emergency days will be made up after June 8 in order to provide 182 instructional days. It is sometimes necessary to close school early in the day due to weather conditions or building issues. Please be sure your child knows where to go in such instances if there is no one to receive your child at home.

Physical Examinations

It is required that all children be examined by their private physician prior to kindergarten and any time during grades 3, 6, and 10. All completed physical exam forms (blue forms) must be submitted to the school nurse prior to the start of kindergarten and grades 4, 7, and 11.

Communicable Disease Regulations

<u>Disease</u>	<u>Re-Admittance To Schools</u>
Chicken Pox	After 7 days from onset of rash.
Measles	After 5 days from onset of rash.
Rubella	After 4 days from onset of rash.
Mumps	After all swelling has subsided.

All children are examined by the school nurse, and parents are notified if recovery is not complete. Other children in the family who have not had the disease may attend school. The nurse will watch for symptoms.
