

**BOARD OF EDUCATION OF FAYETTE COUNTY CONTRACT
FOR APPOINTMENT OF ACTING SUPERINTENDENT**

This CONTRACT entered this 20th day of July 2026, by and between the BOARD OF EDUCATION OF FAYETTE COUNTY, KENTUCKY ("Board"), and Dr. William Bradford (Dr. Bradford), memorializes lawful action of the Board first taken on June 10, 2026.

By vote unanimously passed at a duly called meeting on June 10, 2026, the Board appointed Dr. Bradford to serve as Acting Superintendent pending resolution of a review regarding the Superintendent's employment being conducted by an independent law firm as authorized by the Board on June 10, 2026.

Because that review is ongoing, and because it is appropriate to memorialize the terms and compensation attendant to Dr. Bradford's appointment and services to the school district as Acting Superintendent, the Board and Dr. Bradford, for the consideration specified below, agree as follows:

I. TERM OF APPOINTMENT.

Dr. Bradford's appointment as Acting Superintendent began June 10, 2026, with the Board's action by majority vote that same date and shall continue until resolution of the above-referenced review of the Superintendent's employment, or until such other time as may be agreed upon between the Board and Dr. Bradford or terminated as provided below, with Dr. Bradford acknowledging he has no expectation of appointment as Acting Superintendent until any specified date.

II. DUTIES.

The duties and responsibilities of Dr. Bradford as Acting Superintendent shall be all those duties incident and attendant to the Office of Superintendent imposed by the laws and regulations of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and in keeping with Board Policy, and such other duties and responsibilities as may be assigned to him from time to time by the Board.

III. OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES.

Dr. Bradford shall devote his time, attention and energy to the business of the Fayette County Public Schools.

IV. COMPENSATION.

In addition to Dr. Bradford's Dr. Bradford's existing compensation as a certified employee and Assistant Superintendent for Fayette County Public Schools, Dr. Bradford shall receive additional compensation from July 1, 2026 until termination of this Contract at the daily rate of Three Hundred Twelve Dollars and Forty Nine Cents (\$312.49) per work day, to be paid in bi-monthly installments on the same dates administrators employed full-time by the school district are paid. This daily rate is calculated from the Board's existing salary and administrative additive schedules.

V. BENEFITS AND EXPENSES.

- A. Retirement Benefits. Any additional retirement benefits beyond Dr. Bradford's existing Continuing Contract for Employment as a Certified Employee shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Kentucky Teachers' Retirement System, with any additional employer and employee contribution to the retirement system due as a result of the Acting Superintendent compensation addressed above to be paid by the Board.
- B. All other benefits shall remain as already provided for Dr. Bradford as a certified employee pursuant to his existing Continuing Contract for Employment as a Certified Employee and Board Policy.

VI. BOARD POLICY.

Dr. Bradford's duties and obligations are governed by Board Policy unless modified herein. All employment benefits provided to Dr. Bradford are as specifically enumerated in this Contract and shall supersede any general policy applicable to other employees of the board.

VII. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT.

This Contract may be terminated as specified in the Board's policy and shall also be subject to termination as follows:

- A. By expiration of the term of this Contract;
- B. By the rescinding of this Contract by majority vote of the Board;
- C. By mutual agreement of the parties in writing; or
- D. By discharge for legal cause.

Termination of this Contract for Dr. Bradford's appointment as Acting Superintendent shall not terminate or alter his underlying position as Assistant Superintendent or his existing Continuing Contract of Employment with the Fayette County School District.

VIII. NOTICE.

Any notice or communication permitted or required under the terms of this Contract shall be in writing and shall become effective on the day of the mailing thereof by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, and addressed:

IX. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

If, during the term of this Contract, it is found that a specific cause hereof is illegal or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of the Contract not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

X. MISCELLANEOUS.

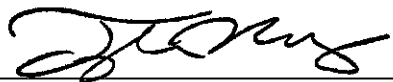

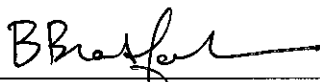
