Dear Parents and Students of the **Class of 2027**,

Please review the following information with your child, as it will help ensure the safety and welfare of our students. Parents and guardians, please remind your children that driving is a privilege at MHS, not a right. Students must adhere to the expectations set forth by the MHS administration to avoid having their parking privileges revoked.

QUALIFICATIONS: To qualify for a parking permit, a student must be a senior and submit the following by **October 9th, 2026**.

****All Items listed must be turned in before receiving your parking tag****

- ☐ Completed application
- ☐ Current driver's license
- ☐ Auto insurance card
- ☐ Current vehicle registration
- ☐ \$125.00 check made payable to Montgomery High School

You can/should apply for a parking permit by Oct. 9th, 2026, even if you plan to get your license by May 2027.

***If you are signing up for the carpooling option, fill out this portion with the second student. You should register both of your cars so that either of you can drive. Only one hang tag will be issued for both cars*.**

STUDENT DRIVER EXPECTATIONS:

To ensure the safety and well-being of all MHS students, staff, and Montgomery residents, we have certain expectations of you as student drivers. There will be negative consequences if you do NOT adhere to these expectations. If you adhere to these expectations, you will enjoy the freedom of driving to school.

- Students are expected to park in their assigned numbered parking space only.
- Students will **NOT** share their space with other students.
- Students are expected to arrive at school on time in the morning.
- Student drivers must abide by the MHS code of conduct while attending school or school-sponsored functions.
- Students must have their parking hang tag displayed at all times on school property.
- Hang tags are not transferable to any other student without prior approval for ANY reason.
- Students are expected to drive safely AT ALL TIMES. The speed limit on campus is set at **10 MPH**.
- Student drivers are expected to remain on campus AT ALL TIMES during the school day.

The administration MUST grant special permission if a student driver wishes to leave campus for any reason.

Conduct: Please see the student handbook code of conduct section for more information on parking violation discipline. Below is a list of infractions that constitute parking violations.

Excessive Unexcused Absences	Excessive Tardies
Failure to report an accident on school grounds	Leaving school grounds without permission
Lending Someone Your Hangtag	Parking In the Wrong Spot w/ Parking Privileges
Parking Without Parking Privileges	Reckless driving and or speeding on school grounds
Selling your hangtag	Sharing your parking spot without prior approval
Suspension	Violation of the school alcohol/controlled substance policy

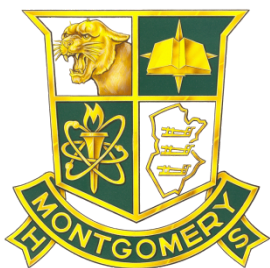
