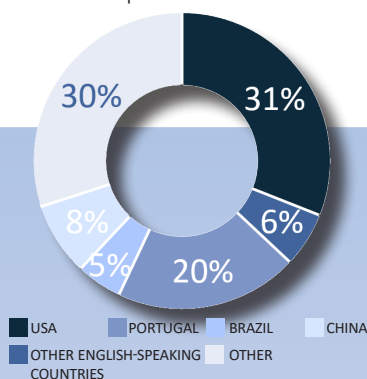


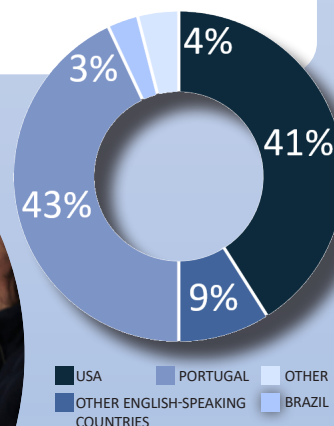
ENROLLMENT

The total enrollment at CAISL is 757 students, with 319 in Early Childhood 3 through Grade 5 and 438 in Grades 6 through 12. Of the total student body, 237 (31%) are U.S. citizens, 149 (20%) are host-country nationals, and 371 (49%) are third-country nationals, including 44 from English-speaking countries such as Canada, the United Kingdom, and Australia. Among U.S. students, 56 are dependents of U.S. government direct-hire or contract employees, while 181 are other private U.S. citizens.



PROFESSIONAL STAFF

CAISL employs 107 full-time faculty members. Of these, 44 (41%) are U.S. citizens, 10 (9%) are from other English-speaking countries, including the United Kingdom, Canada, and Ireland, and 46 (43%) are host-country nationals. The remaining 7% represent additional nationalities, including Brazil and Romania. All faculty members are either native English speakers or fully bilingual.



The Carlucci American International School of Lisbon (CAISL) is a non-profit, non-denominational college preparatory school serving students from Early Childhood (age 3) through Grade 12 (age 18). CAISL provides a high-quality education based on the American model, using English as the primary language of instruction.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate, students must earn a minimum of 27 academic credits during Grades 9-12 (1 credit represents a full-year course). The credit requirements are as follows: 4 credits in English, 3 credits in Mathematics, 3 credits in Science, 3 credits in Social Studies, 2 credits in a Foreign Language, 3 credits in Physical Education, 1 credit in Computer Science, 1 credit in Fine Arts, and 7 credits in Electives.

GRADING

The High School uses the letter grades A+ to F. The minimum passing grade is D (60%). CAISL reports incidents of academic malpractice, suspensions or exclusions which occur in the student's last three semesters of attendance. Grade point average applies only to courses taken at CAISL, and the school does not produce student rankings.

With a diverse international community, CAISL promotes active citizenship in a rapidly changing world and prepares students for global university admissions. The school offers Portuguese language and culture programs, as well as an intensive English as an Additional Language (EAL) program for non-fluent English speakers.

CAISL's comprehensive co-curricular program includes competitive athletics, academic teams such as Model United Nations, and a vibrant array of arts and enrichment opportunities, fostering personal growth and leadership skills.

CAISL is accredited by the Middle States Association (MSA) and licensed by the Portuguese Ministry of Education (ME). The school is also an authorized International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, offering the IB Diploma Program for the final two years of high school. CAISL is the only school in Portugal to receive sponsorship from the U.S. Department of State.

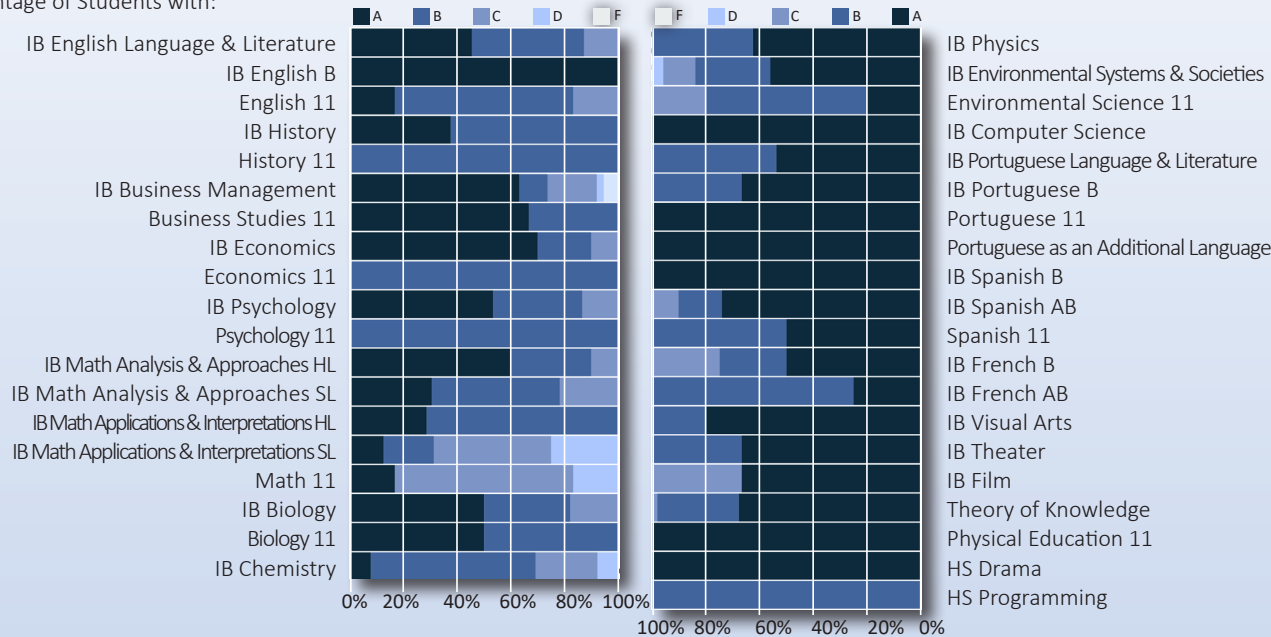

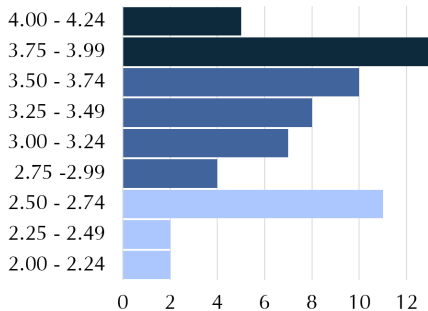

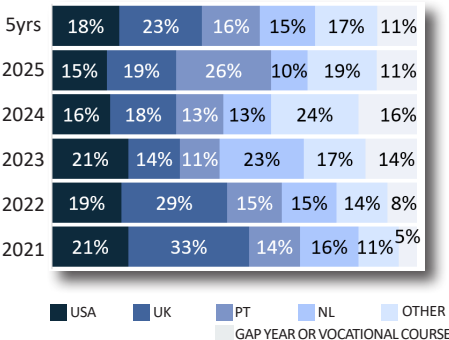

Class of 2026 in Grade 11

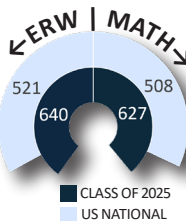

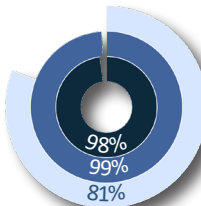
