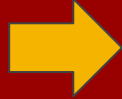


Uni Hill's 50:50 Dual Language Model

50:50 Program Model: Literacy instruction is provided in the two program languages at all grade levels and for the duration of the program.	Partner language	50%	50%	50%	50%	50%	50%

We choose the 50:50 Program Model at Uni Hill. It is an inclusive model in that every student has instruction in both languages every day. Foundational literacy and math skills are developed in the primary grades in both languages, so by the time a student reaches the intermediate grades, they are ready for the shift from “learning to read” to “reading to learn” and have been problem solving in math and science in both languages for several years.
