4.A. Consider, Discuss, and Take Appropriate Action Regarding the 2026-2027 Compensation Plan - APPROVED

At the June workshop meeting, administration discussed three scenarios for compensation increases. Tonight the administration recommends Scenario 2. This plan includes a teacher increase of a step +\$425, which provides an average teacher increase of 1.5%. All other staff would receive a 1.5% increase based on the midpoint of their assigned salary range. As discussed in the June workshop, Scenario 2 also includes adjustments in salary for instructional coordinators and counselors and a stipend for certified high school math and science teachers. Approval of the salary increase also includes a 1% increase to the minimum and maximum amounts on each salary table.
