IMPORTANT UPDATE FOR PPS REPORT CARDS

After February, Pittsburgh Public Schools will no longer mail printed report cards home.

All report cards will be available online through the Home Access Center (HAC). This change helps families access information faster and ensures students' academic records are always available.

What is the Home Access Center?

The **Home Access Center (HAC)** is a secure online portal that allows parents and guardians to view their child's academic information anytime, anywhere.

Through HAC, families can access:

- * Class schedules
- * Attendance records
- * Published assignments
- * Quick links to communicate with teachers
- * Class averages
- * Report card information
- * Transcript grades

Benefits of Using HAC

- * Immediate access to grades and attendance
- * No lost or delayed report cards
- * Multilingual accessibility
- * Ability to download or print report cards anytime

FOR STAFF

- * Reduced printing and mailing needs

Account Information You Should Know

- * If your child is enrolled in PPS, you already have an HAC account.
- * Parents/guardians with children in multiple schools use one account to view all students.
- * If a student is missing from your account, contact your child's school to ensure you are listed correctly as a parent/guardian in the District's student information system (SIS).
- * If more than one parent/guardian needs access, each adult must be listed as a parent/guardian in the SIS.
- * To confirm or update guardian information, contact your child's school.

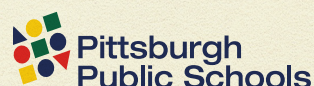
