THE WITHROW WAY

At Withrow University High School, we believe a school dress code promotes a positive learning environment, builds school pride, and supports a strong focus on academics. All students are expected to follow the uniform guidelines outlined below each day, unless otherwise communicated.



APPROVED BOTTOMS (PANTS, SKIRTS, SHORTS)

COLORS: Khaki (Tan/Beige), Black or Grey

STYLES: Pants, joggers, Sweatpants, Capris or slacks. Shorts or Skirts must be mid-thigh to knee-length.

GUIDELINES:

- ✓ Bottoms must be worn at the waist
- ✓ Skirts and shorts must be a modest length that covers the upper leg, from mid-thigh to knee-length
- ✓ Clothing that is too short, excessively tight, sagging, ripped or revealing is not allowed

APPROVED UNIFORM TOPS (COLLARED SHIRTS OR WITHROW BRANDED T-SHIRTS)

COLLARED SHIRTS

Collared shirts can be worn in ANY COLOR. School Colors (Black, Grey, White, Orange) are Preferred, but any SOLID color is permitted.

T-SHIRTS

T-Shirts are permitted to show school pride in School Colors Only: Black, Grey, White, Orange or School color combination. NO OTHER COLOR T-Shirts are permitted.



GUIDELINES:

- ✓ Must have a collar (collared shirt style) unless wearing a Withrow branded or solid Withrow Color T-shirt
- ✓ Shirts must cover the midriff and may not be oversized or excessively tight.



OPTIONAL LAYERS (FOR WARMTH)

Withrow-branded sweatshirts, hooded sweatshirts, crewnecks, quarter-zips, and full-zip jackets in ANY color, but any logo must be school appropriate.

No hoods may be worn over the head inside the building.



FOOTWEAR

APPROVED

Closed-toe shoes that cover the whole foot only. (Gym shoes, loafers, dress shoes)



NOT PERMITTED

Slippers, slides, flip-flops, or high heels over 2 inches



ACCESSORIES

- ✓ Student ID badges are required to enter the school building, must be visible, displayed above the waist and worn at all times.
- ✓ Jewelry must be school-appropriate, not a safety issue and not disruptive to learning.
- ✓ No head coverings unless worn for religious or medical reasons.
- ✓ No hats, scarves, durags, bonnets, bandanas, sunglasses, face coverings, ski masks, or beanies.
- ✓ Headphones, including over-ear models, are not permitted to be worn in hallways or common areas like the cafeteria or auditorium. Classroom use is at the discretion of the teacher.



PROHIBITED ITEMS – NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING

The following items are not permitted inside the school building:

- Masks or Ski masks of any color



Students who bring prohibited items to school must leave them at the front of the building. Items will be retrieved at the end of the day on an honor system.

Withrow University High School is not responsible for lost or stolen items or clothing.



STUDENT AND PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

Parents and guardians are expected to ensure students arrive in uniform each day.



DRESS CODE EXEMPTION FOR TEAMS AND CLUBS ON GAME DAYS AND SPECIAL CLUB EVENTS
