The Rolling Admissions is designed for students who demonstrate academic excellence, high English proficiency, and a proactive desire to achieve their goals. By reviewing applications as they arrive, we create a continuous opportunity for motivated students to secure their place. Furthermore, we are committed to reaching out to a diverse demographic, our school's development and play a vital role in the growth and success of their peers.

Eligibility:

- ① Meeting the application qualifications for the general entrance examination of this school.
- ② Having enrolled at a school outside of Japan for three or more years. (Japanese schools outside Japan or international schools in Japan are excluded.)
- ③ Must demonstrate a CEFR B2 level of English proficiency or higher. As proof of meeting this requirement, official score reports issued by the respective testing organizations for any English proficiency test—including but not limited to TOEFL, IELTS, EIKEN, and Duolingo—will be uniformly accepted as valid qualification for application, provided that the original documents are submitted.
- ④ Obtaining the following Standardized Test score(s) is recommended.

SSAT / ISEE / PSAT (8-9, 10) / SAT (Reasoning Test) / ACT

<Special Note>

- You can only apply once per admissions cycle.
- You can simultaneously apply for the general entrance examinations (Fall Admissions, Spring Admissions I and/or Spring Admissions II). However, if you pass one of them, you must withdraw the other.
- The English proficiency test score submission requirement is waived for applicants who exited an ESL program or an equivalent English support program at least two years prior to the application date.
- Written test is exempt for those who passed Step 1.

Selection Process	Step 1 : Documents Screening Step 2 : Interview 20-30 minutes in English and Japanese (In-person or online depending on the applicant's place of residence)
Notification of Pass/Fail	Step 1 results : Notified approximately one week after application completion. Step 2 results : Notified approximately one week after the completion of the interview.
