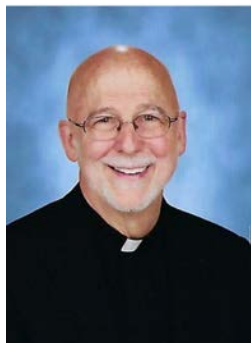

The Big Picture with Fr. Bob



Dear Friends,

This weekend, the Archdiocese of Detroit is celebrating the feast day of Saints Joachim and Anne, parents of Mary, our Blessed Mother. We also honor them as being the grandparents of Jesus.

Tradition tells us that Saints Joachim and Anne were feeling desolate because they were childless. After

much prayer and fasting, they were blessed with a child. They knew their daughter was a special gift and dedicated her to God.

St. Anne has been chosen as the patron saint for our Archdiocese. We entrust our Archdiocese to her love and care. She, who with St. Joachim watched over Mary who brought forth into the world our Savior, is well equipped to watch over all the needs of the Archdiocese of Detroit. We do well during this time of Archdiocesan Restructuring to ask for St. Anne's loving intercession.

Today, throughout the world, the Church celebrates the "World Day of Prayer for Grandparents and the Elderly." Some of us never had the opportunity to meet one or more of our grandparents. I am sure they have been praying for us, nonetheless. Maybe they passed away when you were young and you have very few memories of them. Still, the role of grandparents is very unique, and I am sure they are praying for you!

If you are fortunate enough to still have one or more grandparents alive, then today is a great day to tell them how much you love and appreciate them.

I know from firsthand experience that the elderly like to reminisce. They may not have the sharpest memory for current events, but often they are able to recall great stories from their younger years. This is a great time to help piece together parts of your family history. Whether it is one of your grandparents or an elderly person in your neighborhood, you can bring joy into their lives by sharing the gift of time with them.

There is an old saying, "Grandparents make the world... a little softer, a little kinder, a little warmer." I believe that is normally true. May we show our appreciation on a regular basis. None of us should be so busy that we cannot pick up a phone and have a five-minute conversation with a grandparent. The elderly appreciate knowing they have not been forgotten.

If your grandparents have already gone home to the Lord, we can do something wonderful for them by sending up a prayer for them. (It is better than a Hallmark card!)

As we celebrate this feast day, let us end with a prayer:

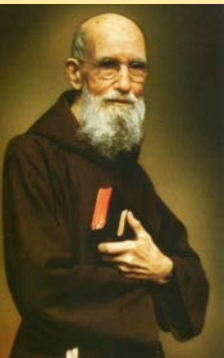

At that time, all of the feedback received will be carefully reviewed and help refine the proposed models. Your feedback is essential. Pray

Pray before, during, and after filling out the online survey. Invite the Holy Spirit to work through you as you answer the questions, remove any barrier or bias, and help you share what works or doesn't work in the proposed models. Please continue to pray for our parishes, clergy, and all those involved in this process.

Review Your Planning Area Models

Take time to review the proposed models for your planning area. Be sure to watch all of the planning area videos before completing the survey, especially if you were unable to attend a listening session. 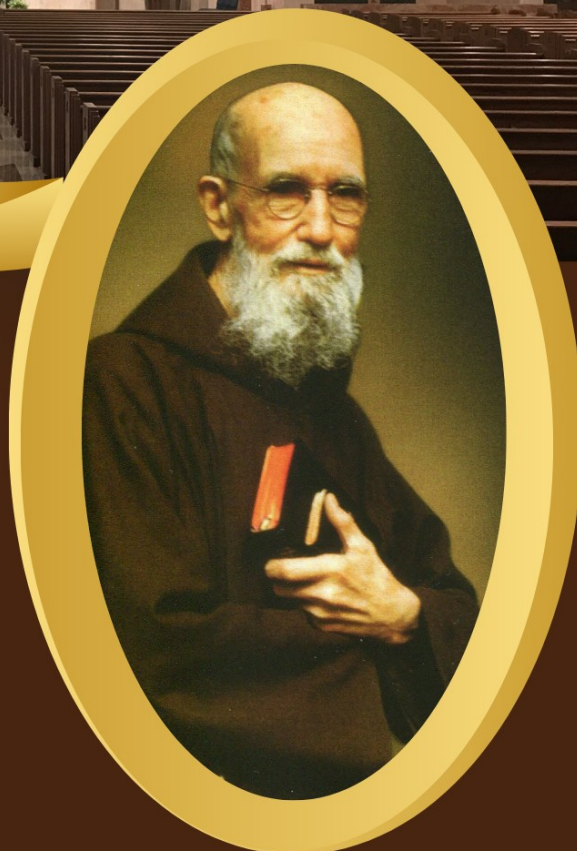

SAFE ENVIRONMENTS: Volunteer Requirements



UNITED STATES CONFERENCE OF
CATHOLIC BISHOPS



The Archdiocese of Detroit, in compliance with the USCCB Charter for Protection of Youth and Young People, **requires any and all parish and school volunteers to complete Protecting God's Children training and maintain a current background check, regardless of whether they are interfacing with children or vulnerable adults.** Please review the steps below to ensure you are in full compliance.

Create and/or login to VIRTUS Account

VIRTUS is the Church's online system for Protecting God's Children training and volunteer safety compliance. All information shared within VIRTUS is secure and encrypted for online security. Please visit **VIRTUS.org** to get started.

New users: Create an account.

Returning users: Log in with your current credentials to access courses, authorize background checks, recertify or update your information.

Quick tip: Keep your login handy for future training updates or renewals.

Authorize Background Check

Upon registering with VIRTUS, **new users** will provide their date of birth, gender, race, and confirm Michigan residency for the past 7 years, followed by signing and authorizing the background check.

Your VIRTUS account will show the check as cleared once it has been completed by our on-staff VIRTUS coordinator in strict confidentiality.

Review & Sign Volunteer Code of Conduct

All volunteers are required to read and sign the Volunteer Code of Conduct. This can be completed by logging into your VIRTUS account.

If needed, a paper copy may also be reviewed and signed; completion will be recorded in your VIRTUS account under the "Required Documents" tab.

All Divine Child parish and school volunteers - new and currently serving - are expected to complete all four steps prior to volunteering.

Sign up & Attend Protecting God's Children Training

Protecting God's Children (PGC) is a 3-hour awareness session that educates adults on how to recognize inappropriate or predatory behavior, take steps to prevent abuse, and report concerns responsibly.

First-time participants must attend an in-person *Protecting God's Children 4.0* session, while **anyone who completed PGC in 2022 or earlier** may complete a recertification online through the VIRTUS web training module (*Protecting God's Children 4.0* and *Vulnerable Adults 2.0*).

How to Register

All registration is completed online through your VIRTUS account. VIRTUS offers sessions across metro Detroit (see database in your account).



Rainforest Falls was our Vacation Bible School program for our Family of Parishes this year!
