Grading

Elementary

- Reported through standards and concepts of reading, writing, numeracy, social studies, and science. Mastery is reported as accomplished, meeting, developing, beginning, insufficient evidence, not assessed, or support.

Secondary

- Reported through standards and criterion-based. Students earn scores of 1-8. Grades are converted to a 0-100 scale for transcripts. AP classes are given an additional 0.5 weighting. Highest GPA 4.18 Mean GPA 3.75

Services
