We will serve *all* of our students by focusing on the following goals within a comprehensive and coherent PK–12 framework.

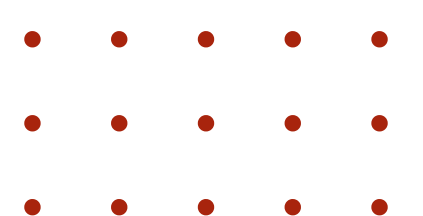
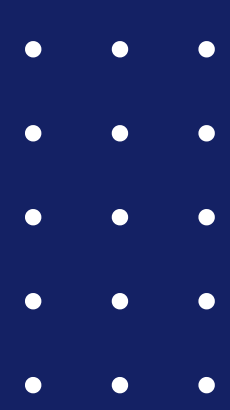

Goal 1:

Foster a culture of academic excellence, innovation, and equity, where students are provided with personalized learning experiences, rigorous curriculum, and supportive resources to achieve their full potential.

- Implemented curriculum initiatives, including i-Ready Math, Reveal Math, Amplify Desmos Math, OpenSciEd, and new STEM programming.
- Expanded instruction supports through enhanced WIN intervention blocks, Tier I intervention resources, and updated elementary schedules that increased ELA and Math instructional time.
- Strengthened literacy through Magnetic Literacy pilots, language comprehension professional learning, digital literacy screening, and accessibility tools.
- Increased college and career readiness through AP Capstone, expanded computer science pathways, dual enrollment partnerships, and Seal of Biliteracy participation.
- Provided extensive professional learning focused on instructional best practices, sheltered instruction, building thinking classrooms, and technology integration.
- Enhance data driven instruction through districtwide LinkIT!, IXL, universal screening, data chats, and intervention protocols.



Goal 2:

Cultivate the wellness of the WTPS community through intentional programming and supports focused on the physical, social, emotional, behavioral, and technological development of students, staff, and parents/guardians.

- Successfully launched the **7 Mindsets** wellness initiative across all grade levels, including Morning Meetings and Wellness Wednesday.
- Expanded social-emotional learning through monthly wellness lessons, character education, schoolwide activities, and student leadership opportunities.
- Strengthened crisis response through enhanced Threat Assessment, Crisis Management, Lifelines suicide prevention, and restorative practices training.
- Increased collaboration among counselors, administrators, nurses, CST, and intervention teams through ongoing data reviews and coordinated student supports.
- Expanded parent and community engagement through wellness newsletters, parent presentations, mental health awareness programming, and community partnerships.
- Continued development of comprehensive Tier II and Tier III supports to address students' academic, behavioral, and emotional needs.

Goal 3:

Strengthen engagement and expand opportunities that foster a sense of belonging and purpose through inclusive experiences that promote positive peer and community relationships

- Expanded student engagement through Unified Sports, Unified Club, adaptive programming, extracurricular activities, and leadership opportunities.
- Increased family involvement through PTO partnerships, Family Fun and Fitness events, parent nights, and transition programs.
- Celebrated community through America 250/Wall 175 programming, Veterans Day events, Read Across Wall, and districtwide celebrations.
- Expanded Computer Science awareness, marching band competitions, and music program recognition.
- Strengthened partnerships through SEPAG meetings, college planning presentations, and continued expansion of the RISE program.



Goal 4:

Practice fiscal responsibility while maintaining facilities for student learning in the 21st century, which includes clear and accurate reporting to the stakeholders.

- Continued successful management of the 2022 Referendum projects with regular Board and community updates.
- Advanced construction projects, including HVAC improvements, athletic fields, roofing, and interior renovations.
- Maintained strong fiscal oversight through investment management and capital planning.
- Continued long-range facilities planning by analyzing enrollment trends and future district needs.
- Advanced planning for a centralized Support Services Complex to improve operational efficiency.



Goal 5:

Cultivate timely, consistent, effective, and equitable communications through reciprocal collaboration with all stakeholders to inform and inspire the District and greater community.

- Strengthened communication with families and community stakeholders through multiple outreach initiatives and feedback opportunities.
- Expanded communication platforms through implementation of the district AI Chatbot.
- Maintained consistent and timely communication through Board presentations, referendum updates, website enhancements, newsletters, and daily social media outreach.
- Continued partnerships with state and national communication organizations.
