

POLICY REVISION AND REVIEW

In an effort to keep its written policies up to date so that they can be used consistently as a basis for **North Middlesex Regional** School Committee action and administrative ~~decisions~~**decision**, the Committee will review its policies on a regular basis.

In its review, the Committee will evaluate how policies have been implemented. It will consider feedback from school staff, students, and the community when revising policies, as appropriate.

The Superintendent is expected to call to the attention of the Committee all policies that are out of date or for other reason appear to need revision.

~~The **School** Committee will evaluate how the policies have been executed by the school staff and will weigh the results. It will rely on the school staff, students, and the community for providing evidence of the effect of the policies it has adopted. ¶~~

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~~The Superintendent is given the continuing commission of calling to the Committee's attention all policies that are out of date or for other ~~reasons~~**reason** appear to need revision. ¶~~

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~~The School Committee directs the Superintendent to periodically recall all policy and regulations manuals for administrative updating and Committee review. ¶~~
