Uses of Funding for Disadvantaged Pupil Impact Aid and Student Wellness and Success Funds

DPIA Funding Use

1. Reading Improvement and Intervention

Grades K-6 Certificated Staff received professional development in reading improvement and intervention and were trained in RTI (Response to Intervention) for students not meeting grade level criteria. Identified students received intervention relative to the deficiencies in various academic content standards.

2. School Resource Officer

Leetonia EVSD contracts with the Leetonia Police Department to provide a School Resource Officer for campus safety/security. The SRO is a lead resource for any school related issues.

Student Wellness and Success Funding Use

1. Community Liaison

Leetonia Schools utilizes a School/Family Community Engagement Liaison to help mediate student related issues relative to the school and student families. The liaison works with students during the day and communicates to parents regarding attendance, discipline and social emotional issues that may need to be communicated to parents during the school day. Home visits are also part of the liaison's duties.

2. K-12 Counselors

K-12 counselors work to help provide academic, social emotional and career opportunities.

3. Physical Health Services

The K-12 nurse is essential in the health of the student population.

4. Before/After School Program

Leetonia Schools implemented the "Bear Care Before and After Care Program" to help the community in terms of latch key programs and the general need for child care during parents working hours. A mix of academics and enrichment programs are offered in the program. Supplies, teaching resources and salary for staff are necessary expenditures.
