3 BREAKFAST/LUNCH MEAL PRICE CHANGES

Elementary school breakfast is \$1.70 and lunch is \$3.10. Middle/high school breakfast is \$1.85 and lunch is \$3.35. Some qualified students will receive meals at no cost.



4 EASY, SECURE SCHOOL PAYMENTS

“SchoolCash Online” offers a simple, secure way to pay for school fees and activities. Parents can pay for field trips, athletics, clubs, and more anytime, anywhere.

5 EMERGENCY CONTACTS FOR STUDENTS

Families are encouraged to review and update their student’s contact info in Infinite Campus so we can quickly reach parents or guardians in emergencies.



6 DIGITAL SAFETY SUPPORT

FCS offers Qustodio that helps families monitor and manage their child’s online activity. Parents can view screen time, track searches, and set limits for safety.

7 STUDENT DEVICE PROTECTION PLAN

The optional Student Device Protection Plan helps cover the cost of repairs or replacement for district-issued devices due to accidental damage, loss, or theft.

9 FULTON VIRTUAL TUITION UPDATE

Fulton Virtual offers online courses for students in grades 6–12. Tuition will increase to \$250 per semester on July 1. Discounted rates are available to qualified students.
