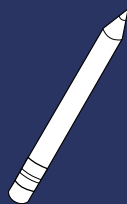
EVENT DETAILS

RULES & EXPECTATIONS

- Students are allowed to use any art materials of their choice, including but not limited to, pencils, paints, pastels, clay, or digital tools. However, materials that pose safety hazards or cause significant mess may be restricted by the competition organizers. All materials must be brought by the student including work surface (paper, canvas, etc.). No materials will be provided.
- Students are responsible for the clean up and organization of all work and material. Limited access to sinks and garbage cans will be available.
- Each student will be assigned a workspace and grouped by grade level category. Labels indicating student name, district, and category will be placed at their assigned workspace. These labels must remain visible at all times. Every effort will be made to provide equitable space for each student. Flexibility and cooperation is expected of all students.
- Students working digital must ensure that the judges have access to the work during the scheduled lunch period. Students should also ensure that all devices are charged for the event. There will be limited access to outlets.
- Students may use additional resources for reference or inspiration while completing their work.
- Students will have until 11:30 AM to create. If arrival and the announcement takes less time than expected, that additional time will be used to create. Additional work time will not be provided for late arrivals or breaks.
- Students must conduct themselves with respect towards fellow participants and organizers throughout the competition. Any form of cheating, sabotage, or disrespectful behavior will result in immediate disqualification.
