**RESOLUTION 17-004
AD-HOC PUBLIC SAFETY COMPLEX BUILDING COMMITTEE**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Town of Scarborough, Maine, in Town Council assembled, that,

WHEREAS, the Town Council does hereby recognize the importance of a new Public Safety Complex, which would combine the Police and the central Fire Station, as identified as the highest priority in the Long Range Facility Plan; and,

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2016, the Town Council approved establishing the Ad-Hoc Public Safety Complex Building Committee charged to prepare a Report and Recommendations; and,

WHEREAS, the Committee has completed its work and fulfilled its charge within the requested timeframe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Scarborough, in Town Council assembled, that, with its work completed, the Ad Hoc Public Safety Complex Committee recommends to the Town Council that their existence be extended and their charge be modified to focus their efforts on education, outreach and promotion of the project leading up to the Referendum in November.
