- Pencil box or pouch (large enough to hold all school tools i.e., scissors, pencils, crayons, glue etc.)

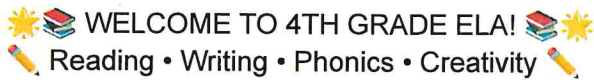
Additional supplies needed:

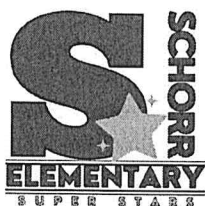

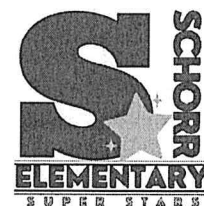

How to Access Our Amazon School Supply List

1. **Open your Camera:** Open the camera app on your smartphone (iPhone or Android).
2. **Point and Scan:** Hold your device so that the **QR code** (located at the bottom of the welcome letter) appears clearly in the viewfinder.
3. **Tap the Link:** A yellow or white link/banner will pop up on your screen. Tap it to be directed straight to our 4th Grade classroom list on Amazon.
4. **Shop or Save:** You can then add items directly to your cart and checkout when you are ready.

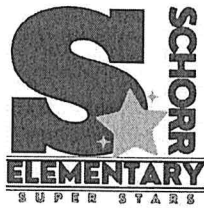

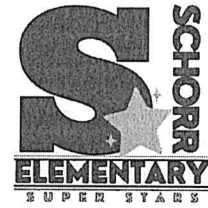

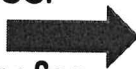
