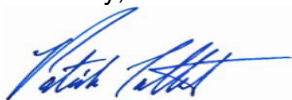
To our dedicated faculty and staff, thank you for your unwavering commitment to our students. Your passion and professionalism make a lasting difference in the lives of young people each day.
